

FIREWORKS STORAGE

Need to visualize the “do’s” and “don’t’s” of fireworks storage? View the images below for a graphical representation of the fireworks storage requirements contained within Bulletin 51.



Note:
Fireworks contained within family pack or cellophane wrapping may be merchandised in areas allowing direct consumer access.



- 1 Lots of fireworks on display exceed 25 kilograms.
- 2 Accelerants displayed near fireworks.
- 3 Individual articles are accessible to the public, and are not contained in cellophane wrapping.
- 4 Lots exceed 25 kilograms. Cardboard is not a sufficient fire break to prevent the spread of fire.
- 5 Loose fireworks are out of the reach of the public. Fireworks are divided into 25 kilogram lots, with sufficient separation. No accelerants are stored near the fireworks.

Note:
All quantities in these regulations refer to the Gross Weight of the fireworks. This includes the articles and any packaging in which they may be sold.



EXAMPLES: BULLETIN #51



- Display board with live fireworks out of public reach
- "No Smoking" sign
- Approved packaging
- Shelves out of reach of public

Consumer fireworks on display must be separated into lots not exceeding 25 kg gross weight. The separation must be sufficient to prevent fire from spreading rapidly from one lot to the next, e.g., a 6-mm plywood partition that extends 15 cm above the height of the lot or to the display shelf above.

Consumer fireworks on display must be separated into lots not exceeding 25 kg gross weight. The separation must be sufficient to prevent fire from spreading rapidly from one lot to the next and may consist, for example, of:

- An aisle with a minimum width of 1.1 metres, or
- a 6-mm plywood partition that extends 15 cm above the height of the lot or to the display shelf above.

Fireworks on display must be in approved packaging (e.g., family or blister pack), a glass case, or other suitable receptacles (e.g., shelves that are out of reach of the public). Fireworks articles not in approved packaging must be made inaccessible to the public.

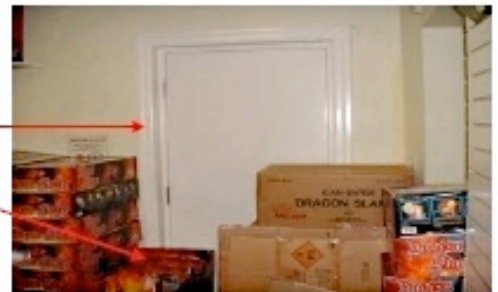
Customers are not permitted to handle any fireworks articles that are not in approved packaging until the articles have been purchased.
